

Temperature & Precipitation



Summary

The climatological average precipitation amount in August is higher than for any other month, 3.2 inches. The last time that we had an August that reached average was in 2016. But after a very hot and dry first half of the month, frequent and productive monsoon thunderstorms in the second half pushed the monthly total to 3.22 inches, slightly above average. The University of Arizona plot of total monsoon season precipitation so far (from June 15 through September 9) shows that Los Alamos and Santa Fe totals are average or a little above, and most parts of New Mexico have done well, except for the western edge.



Temperatures in August were about 5°F above average. August 8th was the second-hottest August day on record, and it was one of six days that are in the top eleven for the month.
