


Weather at Los Alamos

Temperature & Precipitation




Summary

After temperatures in January were about 4 degrees above average, February's temperatures have been even warmer, about 8 degrees above average. Although there was only one record daily high temperature, the big story is that the warm temperatures have been so consistently above average all through the month, with only 4 cooler-than-average days out of 28. The map below shows that these warm conditions have covered the entire western half of the country, caused by an extremely persistent upper-level ridge of high pressure.

The other big story is that after only 1 inch of snowfall in February, the total winter snowfall has been less than 9 inches, about 25% of the expected amount.
