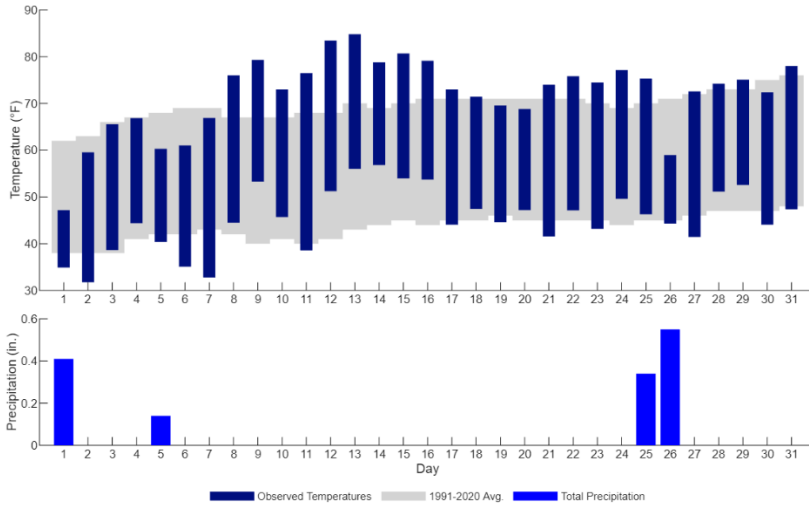


Weather at Los Alamos

Temperature & Precipitation



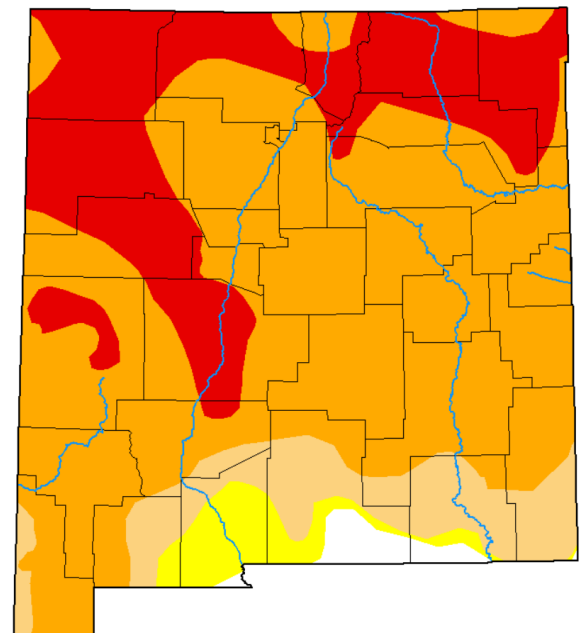
Summary

The streak of warmer than normal months has reached a full year, as the last time temperatures were cooler than normal was May 2025. Most of the month was near normal, except for about a week when temperatures reached the mid-80s.

Storms at the beginning and end of the month provided some relief from the lack of rain, resulting in slightly above-average precipitation. This ended the five-month streak of below-average precipitation. However, Los Alamos is still only at 60 percent of normal precipitation for the year. As shown below, the U.S. Drought Monitor continues to categorize most of New Mexico as experiencing at least severe drought conditions.
