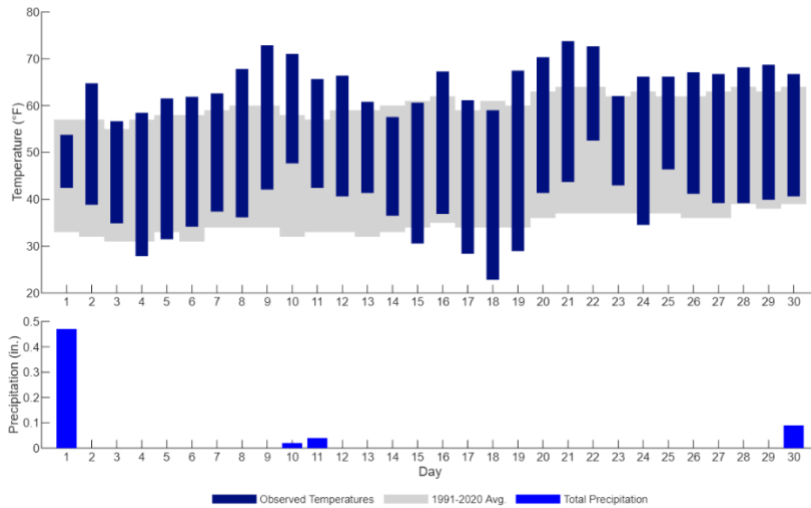


Weather at Los Alamos

Temperature & Precipitation

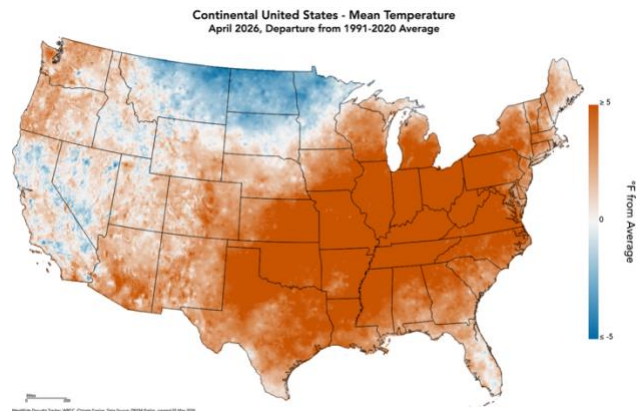


Summary

March was extreme in every way, with an all-time record high March temperature of 83°F and only one hundredth of an inch of rain during the entire month. April was also warm and dry, but far less extreme. Los Alamos was about four degrees above average and most of the continental U.S. was warm as shown below, but not the entire country as in March. Average temperatures in April were actually about three degrees **cooler** than March, which is highly unusual. There were five days below freezing, with the coldest day of 23°F on the 18th.
