


Setting up a workbench in Ariba



If you haven't customized your workbench, your screen will look like this. Click the "+" sign to begin setup.






Customize your workbench based on your work role: click the "+" next to the tiles you want on your workbench.






Click "apply" when finished.






Now your workbench is set to your preferred selections.





Setting up a workbench


The new workbench consists of configurable tiles and worklists, supported with guided actions. Optimize the tiles by changing the order, names, what documents are displayed in the worklist, and the layout of the worklist.





Setting up a workbench: "edit filter"


The "edit filter" link will show you filtering criteria for that specific tile. Select filter criteria by clicking the dropdown options for each field or entering text. The yellow highlighted icon in this image appears when more than one option can be selected for that field. Click "apply" to see the results.






Setting up a workbench: "save filter"

The save filter link will allow you to save your filter criteria. Provide a description for your tile to help you identify it in the future.





Setting up a workbench: customize workbench



The customize icon on the workbench will bring up the edit workbench page. On this page, you can add, remove and reorder your tiles.

To add a tile, click the "+" icon. This will bring up a list of available tiles. Click the "+" sign again to add the tile. The workbench can support a maximum of 25 tiles.


To remove a tile, click on the "x" icon on the top right of the tile.

To reorder your tiles, drag the two horizontal lines on the top of each tile and drop them into the desired position. The order of your tiles is how it will appear on your homepage.




Setting up a workbench: tile tooltip

The help icon next to each tile is a tooltip. Clicking the icon will bring up a description of the tile.





Setting up a workbench: table settings




The table settings icon will bring up the list of available and displayed columns. You can configure the table to hide or display columns. Drag and drop column headers to hide or display.

Reorder table columns by dragging and dropping the headers into the desired positions.

Setting up a workbench: export worklist

Exporting a worklist will create an Excel file in the local download folder, using the current filter criteria and worklist settings (i.e., selected columns, groupings, etc.).





Setting up a workbench: document actions

The more icon under the action's column will show you a list of available actions for your document. Clicking on any one of these actions will take you to your network document.
