CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

The NFO curriculum consists of three modules. Each module spans three half-days (Tuesday through Thursday, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.) and is offered 4 sessions a year.

- **Module 1** (WebEx) provides a broad overview of LANL's history, the Nuclear Security Enterprise, the LANL Weapons Programs, and key security principles.
- Module 2 (WebEx) focuses on stockpile stewardship, nuclear weapons science, materials, design, testing, the U.S. nuclear stockpile, and the weapons lifecycle.
- Classified Module 3 (in-person) delves deeper into the topics covered in Modules 1 and 2, offering face-to-face interactions with subject matter experts. Completion of Modules 1 and 2 is required as a prerequisite for Module 3.


